Race 1 - 12:30PM JAMES SQUIRE HANDICAP (1100 METRES)

Rail +4m. Running line should be okay. Field of 7 after the two early scratchings with 4 making their debuts. This looks a good race with some talent engaged.

Very disappointed TRAFFIC WARDEN has come out as he was taking up market percentage and we were against it.

#1 AMAZING EAGLE is the main horse of interest and entitled to be a short favourite. He ran fantastic time (53.6) in winning his sole trial but the most impressive part was his turn of speed at the top of the straight, putting the others in the trial to the sword in a matter of strides. He was strong through the line and looked very professional. All about price for him here as there is a few others who have trialed well leading in.

#2 ANODE ran over a second slower than Amazing Eagle on the same day but looked good in what he did, winning by a margin. #3 MOONRAKER has to be a bit of value at close to \$20 after seeing Wyong on Wednesday. The horse who beat him in that Newcastle trial came out and won very impressively and MOONRAKER arguably trialed as well as him. Taken back and worked home along the inside, finishing off well and strong through the line. Looks talented.

#5 TARDELLI also won a trial leading in.

Definitely have #1 AMAZING EAGLE on top.



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Race 6 - 3:25PM TAB HANDICAP (1100 METRES)

Amnesty has shown speed in the past and can work forward from a wide barrier without surprise. Could follow Boston Rocks over. Martial Music close from 2 and King of Dubai showed speed to lead throughout last time.

With #6 UNION ARMY first up off a bleed today. He's been in the market in all runs to date and was unlucky not to be closer two back before the excuse last time. That SP against a field containing Iowna Merc and Kibou is a sign of his ability. Collett in barrier 1 is his happy place.

Tongue tie goes on and importantly, we loved the trial at Rosehill. Off the bleed, there's no doubt they'll have him fit and ready to go first-up and he looks a lovely each way play.

SELECTION:

#6 UNION ARMY (1x3)

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Race 8 - 4:40PM PRECISE AIR HANDICAP (1400 METRES)

#7 MIRACLE SPIN is a horse of interest on the back of a smart trial on December 5 over 1030m. He was tried over further last campaign and built into his campaign nicely, running consecutive seconds in BM78 company after running superbly in two Midways. It's all about whether 1400m is too short for him today. Blinkers on first time may help with that and adds a bit of intrigue. Don't mind the barrier today and Collett is a go to rider on the program.

#6 CRAFTY EAGLE has to be a strong chance rising to this distance. Sectionals were fantastic last start, running the fourth fastest final 400m of the meeting and race fastest sectionals from the 1000m. #10 VINTAGE CHOICE has been disappointing to date, not quite running to the potential we thought he possessed. He is off a win prior to spelling which is a positive and trials have been positive. Wide barrier for #4 ROBUSTO is not ideal for the stable. He does find Nash and Blinkers first time which is a big watch.

SELECTION:

#7 MIRACLE SPIN each way

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Race 10 - 5:55PM PETALUMA HANDICAP (1200 METRES)

DALAALAAT the likely leader and an even tempo expected.

A few horses off freshen ups coming into this. One of those is #11 SHOHEI off a plain first-up performance. She trialled very well prior to that and we're giving her another chance in this. Ford off for Tim Clark on, positive map in the last race and the tongue tie goes on. Added to that, she is here off a freshen as we said, but she also drops in weight. Plenty of positives for a horse with upside and ability. Queries about main dangers also. CONTEMPORARY has ability and is racing well but he's now deeper into his campaign and he could well be looking for 1400m.

SELECTION:

#11 SHOHEI

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
