14/5/2024 HAWKESBURY

Race 4 – 1:40PM BLAKES MARINE 3YO MAIDEN (1100 METRES)

Track rated a Heavy 8 so monitor the pattern early to see where the best part of the track is. 4 debutantes step out here and the best of them looks to be #1 CRYPTONIC. The trial at Hawkesbury on 16/4 was sharp and he followed that up with another good effort over 742m at Randwick on 30/4. He has led in both of his hit outs, and he should press forward from the good draw in this. Looks a good chance.

#3 SHE'S ALL IT came through the same Hawkesbury trial as Cryptonic before stepping out on debut at Goulburn on 29/4 over 1000m. She sat just behind the leaders there and ran on well to finish 2nd beaten 0.6L. She will have taken good benefit from that and gets in with 56.5kg after Zac Wadick's claim. Can win.

The Godolphin pair #8 GIZA and #10 SETOMBE have both trialled well for this. GIZA has had just the one trial over 793m at Warwick Farm on 26/4. She sat behind the leader on that occasion and worked through the line solidly under no riding to win. The query is that she has only had that one trial leading into this event over 1100m on a wet track as opposed to SETOMBE who presents here first up with the benefit of two trials over 800m and 1000m. Love the way she moved in the first trial at Hawkesbury on 16/4 and her work through the line under a hold. She got back in her 2nd trial but again we loved the way she moved and her strength through the line. She's drawn wide here but that may not be a disadvantage on the heavy track and think she presents value at her current price at \$4.40.

#7 FLYING THINKER's trials have been okay and from the good draw looks one for exotics.
