RACE 2 – 2:00PM PIPE PRO DIRECTIONAL DRILLING MAIDEN (1200M)

Track is a Good 4 for racing at Ballarat today with the rail out 3m the entire circuit.

We've seen more than enough from #7 PRINCE MAGNETITE at the jump outs to suggest he can run a good race here on debut. Thought the last jump out at Flemington on 14/3 was good. He settled back in behind them and came off the heels of the leaders late and looked to have plenty to give. He was under a good grip there and appeared to our eye to have had plenty in hand and could have gone past the leaders if allowed to. He appears to be a nice mover, and this race doesn't look to have any stars in it. Want to have something on him in the small field at \$6. Hoping he can settle in the first pair or two from barrier 3.

The main danger looks to be #6 PODARGONI. Liked the debut effort at Stony Creek over the 1100m on the back of some nice trials. Winkers come off and the blinkers go on and the extra 100m will suit him here given how he found the line on debut. Gets the right run on speed from barrier 2. #8 FRENCH SAVOY was good enough on debut and with the race experience and draw to suit, she looks the other obvious chance.

#3 PALSONAMISSION has been jumping out okay, but the map looks sticky for Cian MacRedmond and happy to bet around it.
