We really liked the jump out of #12 LUNESSA from the Stokes camp on 19/12 at Morphettville. Jumped cleanly, travelled well, and was running away from her opposition under no riding at the end. She was scratched from Saturday and saved for this which looks a much easier affair. Really liked the way she moved and is the clear standout of the debutantes in this race.

#2 THE STING was good on debut in a Morphettville maiden. Showed speed to lead and battled on well and will no doubt have taken a lot of benefit from that run. Of the others that have raced, there haven't been any standout performances, so happy to side with the debutante that has impressed at the trials.

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Race 4 – 2:42PM SPRY CIVIL CONSTRUCTION MAIDEN (1200m)

This doesn't look a strong race at all and as such #5 MOON TREATY is the deserving favourite. We liked its trial prior to bombing the start on debut and making ground late. We were with him 2nd up with the winkers applied but he again bombed the start before making good ground to finish 3rd. Those two runs were at 1000m & 1050m and the way he has run through the line at both suggests 1200m is going to be to his liking. The blinkers go on here as well. Despite all the positive, I don't particularly want to be taking the current prince of \$1.60 with the barrier issues this horse has shown so far in its career.

The horse that we want to be with here is the Jon O'Connor trained #6 OVERSTATED. He trialled on 7/12 at Balaklava and we were impressed with him on that occasion. He was left in front turning for home and looked very green, but when a horse came up outside him to go past him, he knuckled down and ran through the line strongly with it, putting 4 lengths on the 3rd horse. That is a good sign to us that he is a competitive horse. He had a jump out on 19/12 at Morphettville and showed speed there and again impressed us with the way he moved. He may be a little raw, but no doubt he is a nice horse.
