## Race 1 – 1:25PM ALL TOO HARD @ VINERY STUD 3YO BM64 (1200 METRES)

Looks like we will get a Good 4 for this meeting with low winds and sunny conditions forecast for race day. The rail is out 3m.

Nice little race to start the day off with some handy types engaged. #1 PRIVATE LIFE returns fresh for the Waller camp off the back of two good trials. He was given a quiet time in his first trial on 12/8 at this track and we liked his work in his second trial on 27/8. He closed well under no riding there and he looks primed to run a good race here. Draws 1 and cops J Mac so no surprise to see him settle right on speed and have every chance. He was an impressive winner before his spell and with improvement he looks a leading chance.

#6 LILAC is the one that is up and racing and comes into this off the back of a strong first up win at Wyong on 18/8. She sat outside the leader on that occasion and wore down Embassy, who had strong 2yo form and has since won. She draws 3 in this event and looks the likely leader in the race and deserved favourite.

Despite the strong competition, we are siding with #7 RANTAN at around the \$5.50 mark which represents value to us. She is a filly we have had a lot of time for since we first saw her step out at the trials and her work since returning from a spell suggests she has improved since her debut prep. We particularly liked the trial on 19/8 at Randwick where she stalked Blanc De Blanc (who ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in BM78 grade on Saturday) and grabbed her on the line to win. She lengthened nicely when asked by Tim Clark and we are convinced she has come back in particularly good idea. She should stalk the two favourites from the draw and get the last crack at them, and we want to be in her corner at the prices on offer.

## Race 7 – 4:55PM JAMES SQUIRE HANDICAP BM72 (1300 METRES)

We found Ron Quinton in the 1<sup>st</sup> with Rantan and we are hoping he can bookend the card with #3 WATCH MY GIRL in the last. She is another of his runners that we have had on our radar for some time, and we loved the trial leading into this. She sat just off the speed and rounded her rivals up and ran clear without being asked for an effort and showed us that she has improved since her encouraging preparation last time in. She comes into this off only a short break (10 weeks) and the 1300 looks an ideal starting point for her 1<sup>st</sup> up in this. She should be able to sit just behind the speed here and this looks a great race for her.

The clear danger looks to be the Waller trained #13 AELIANA. She was good on debut at Hawkesbury before an impressive win over 1150 on the Kenso last time out. The 1300 looks a big tick for her and providing she doesn't get too far out of her ground looks a major winning chance. Slight query wet to dry, but she is talented.

#14 JUST GLAMOUROUS won well enough first up and looks the leader here. Monitor the track pattern at this stage of the day as if it is playing leaderish then she comes right into calculations.
