Race 2 – 2:55PM JAMES SQUIRE MAIDEN (1550M)

Small field of 6 to contest this maiden and there doesn't look to be much speed on paper. MISS CHENERY jumped well on debut before being caught wide, if she jumps cleanly again here, she can roll forward. Would expect CALANCHE with J Mac on board to roll forward as well.

Keen to be with #6 MISS CHENERY here. Liked her two trials before her debut where she was a touch unlucky in the run but continued to fine the line well, suggesting the step up to 1550m at her 2nd start will be to her liking. She is 3 weeks between runs from her debut with a lovely tick-over trial on 25/1 in between. Love the way her preparation has been trending and keen to be with her here.

The main danger looks to be #5 CALANCHE. Can take up a positive position from the barrier and her two runs in her career to date have been solid. She appears to be looking for the 1550m now as well. #1 FAKHRA trialed well in Melbourne before an underwhelming debut, but she has a chance in this race also. Interesting race with the small field engaged, but as stated, happy to be with MISS CHENERY here.
