Rail in the 9m position from the 1000m mark. Track should play well/reasonably fair. Up and in potentially favoured if anything but that is common on Good rated tracks.

Race 10 - 5:55PM EXPECT IT ALL THIS AUTUMN AT ATC HANDICAP (1200 METRES)

Speed from EITHER OAR who continues to race well, along with WINNING VERSE who has good early toe. Scratchings of Iconic Dame and Euros takes some pressure out of this race but it does mean that our blackbooker #7 TASHI maps to be a little closer now from her low draw.

#7 TASHI comes into this on the back of a superb trial at Canterbury leading in and she can make her presence felt first-up today. While her peak ratings recently have come second up (despite not winning), she has run well first-up in the past and she does look suited in this event today. Track playing fairly and she is a key winning chance.

#1 JUNQUEIRA is a genuine chance and will be charging late. Back in trip the little concern for her but Nash gets on and the blinkers do go on also. Third up and talented. Risking #3 EITHER OAR who has been good to us.

Could back #7 TASHI and save #1 JUNQUEIRA.

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Race 1 - 12:30PM JOIN ATC MEMBERSHIP HANDICAP (1000 METRES)

Kick off with a 2YO race, and a good one at that. Speed from DEPUTIZE and RUSSIAN ROULETTE who will likely set a solid tempo. KALUAKOI maps awkwardly and may need a bit of luck from a wide barrier.

#6 SWITZERLAND is a colt owned by Coolmore who is by Snitzel out of a Group 3 winning mare in the US. He looks a very smooth, balanced mover and a very nice type. Loved his two trials, particularly the first when finding the line between runners under minimal pressure. He then had a trial on his home track at Rosehill running third behind #2 DEPUTIZE who was placed under more pressure. The 1000m does look the query for #6 SWITZERLAND as he may be looking for further but he has a touch of quality about him and he does look the horse to beat. Kerrin McEvoy has ridden in both trials to date and stays on today. He should get a nice run from barrier 2 and with breaks at the right time, will be hard to hold out.

#5 RUSSIAN ROULETTE trialled well at Warwick Farm, beating home #4 KALUAKOI and #15 BLUE ILLUSION. #5 RUSSIAN ROULETTE and #4 KALUAKOI are from the Waterhouse Bott yard who keep producing 2YO winners and they both command respect. #5 RUSSIAN ROULETTE looked good winning that trial but #4 KALUAKOI was not disgraced and was similarly impressive at his Rosehill heat prior. Just risking that trial form reference a little as #15 BLUE ILLUSION is exposed now and think #6 SWITZERLAND has more ability.

Not getting carried away at \$2.40 with SWITZERLAND as he may was further. He does look to have the ability to win this on debut however.
