Race 1 - 12:50PM JAMES SQUIRE HANDICAP (1150 METRES)

Heavy 8 here at Kensington with possible showers throughout the afternoon. Race 1 and first use of the track helps. Kensington can be leaderish, favouring those up and in, particularly early on in the day.

Kick things off with a fillies and mares Maiden over 1150m. EROTAS to lead from KILBADY. SHARPEN THE KNIVES, and I FOUND YOU draw barrier 1 and 2 respectively and likely get nice runs in behind the speed. RNSW map has I FOUND YOU three back the fence which would not be ideal from barrier 2 but hoping they can be a little closer or stay away from that position in run.

We're with #7 I FOUND YOU and have been eagerly awaiting her debut/ We've been waiting for this daughter of I Am Invincible for what seems an eternity now. She first caught the eye at Rosehill back on April 23, running a fast finishing second. She again hit the line very strongly in her trial on May 16, winning that heat and beating home Broadsiding in the process. We've seen what that horse has done recently. #7 I FOUND YOU has been nominated for a large number of races and been held back until now. That is a genuine concern for her here at the price, now almost a month since we've seen her trial, debuting on a wet track. She clearly looks above average and think she wins but not recommending a bet at the \$1.50. Wish she was in a stronger race and we were getting a better price. McDonald on clearly suggests this filly has the talent we think she does.
