## Race 6 – 1:52PM PLC FENCING BM64 (1400 METRES)

#6 WINE BARRON presents here fresh off a very nice piece of work at Gawler on 9/5. He settled just behind the speed on that occasion, and we thought he worked through the line particularly well and showed he has come back in good order this prep. His first up run last preparation over this trip/grade would win this and he has trialled much better leading into this run. Draws 2 and should get every chance to win.

#5 MERCHANT BOSS has returned well his preparation and looks well placed again. This race looks deeper than the first two he has contested this time and not convinced he wants 1400. The positives are that he should find the front pretty comfortably here in a race that looks as if it lacks pressure.

Outside of these two horses, it looks a very even race. #11 BABY ALEX has talent and was a good winner two back prior to a poor effort last time. Blinkers off again. #7 THE BRILL BUILDING gets blinkers for the first time but needs to improve to figure.

## Race 9 – 3:35PM THOROUGHBRED CLUB OF AUSTRALIA BM84 (1400 METRES)

Big field engaged and speed should be genuine. BIGOLINO likely holds a spot from the inside barrier with TALBRAGAR wanting to press forward from out wide. CAWDOR has show speed in it's jump outs also.

We have been very impressed with the trials of the import #17 CAWDOR. He is a stakes placed horse in France that presents first up for the Busuttin & Young yard and if the trials are any guide, he has settled in well in Australia. Loved the way he closed late in his first appearance at the jump outs on 22/4 over 1000m at Cranbourne and he improved again into his 2<sup>nd</sup> on 6/5 over the same track/trip. We were quite taken by the way he moved on that occasion and love the acceleration he showed. He finds a suitable race to kick off in Australia and draws well for Currie. Keen.

#3 RHEINBERG ran well off a 6 week freshen up last time out at Caulfield in a similar race. Draws well to settle closer today from barrier 3 and looks a key winning chance. #7 TALBRAGAR was a good winner at Monington two back before running well in the same race Rheinberg comes through. He faces a tougher task today from the wide draw but is racing consistently and must be a chance.

#9 BIGOLINO goes well at this track and is another one that ran well through the Chorlton Lane race last start. Trialled well since then and looks the one most favoured by the map out of that race. #14 LE FERRARI and #15 BELLE ET RICHE are both consistent horses but find it hard to win, however they must be each way chances also.

### SELECTION:

Very keen **#17 CAWDOR** (win) off the great trials and different form lines.

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
