Rail true and racing on a Good 4 means every horse should get their chance. Speed from SPANISH FOX from the inside gate with KEY LEGEND and LADYKING pushing forward from their middle draws.

We have liked the trials from WEMBANYAMA this time in. Sat wide in his first effort at Randwick on 22/1 over 1050m and extended nicely upon straightening to win. He was asked for an effort on that occasion and liked the way he responded. He sat midfield at his second trial at the same track/trip on 8/2 and won very impressively, letting down in the straight to record a comfortable win. He looks to be moving very nicely at the trials and appears to have matured and improved leading into his 2nd racing preparation. Slight query where he gets to in the run from the outside gate, but if they elect to go back there looks to be enough tempo to bring him in to the race and he looks very hard to beat.

MR CALEB ran well first up over 1200m at Newcastle when settling back in the field and making good ground in the straight. Think that race had a bit of depth to it. No doubt he will have taken improvement from that and the step out to 1400m will be to his liking. Looks the main danger. LADYKING has trialled okay leading into this and was well supported on debut. She looks the one from the on-speed brigade that will be hardest to get past.
